Dear Student,

The Business Office would like to personally welcome you to Mid-America! We consider it a privilege to minister to you, and we are praying for you as you begin this journey.

Payment is considered part of registration. SONIS student accounts must be paid in full, or a Nelnet payment plan must be in place before registration ends. A \$100 Late Registration Fee will be assessed for those missing the deadline. This Late Registration Fee is applicable for all registration periods during your time here.

Cash or check will be accepted for full payments made to the Business Office. You may also pay your account in full through your Sonis student account using a credit or debit card.

Mid-America uses Nelnet to handle our payment plans. Monthly payments can be made using a checking or credit card account. Please note your agreement with Nelnet is only valid for one semester. You must enroll in the Nelnet payment plan or pay in full each semester.

Churches, organizations, or sponsors making payments on your behalf must complete a Third-Party Confirmation form to receive an invoice. This form must be received in our Business Office at least one week before registering for classes. Please be advised failure to do so will delay your registration and may result in additional fees. To verify changes or expiration, this confirmation must be completed annually.

Before classes begin, students may drop or add classes without cost.

Once classes start, tuition is non-refundable and Nelnet payments must be continued throughout the contract. In addition, a \$5 schedule change fee will be assessed.

We are aware unique financial situations arise in the lives of Mid-America families, and we are committed to helping you through those situations. However, continued enrollment requires consistent financial integrity, including acceptable credit standing. You are expected to be prompt and faithful in payment of all tuition and fees to Mid-America.

We in the Business Office look forward to being a helpful part of your education experience.

Power Up

Power Up is an online, 8-week class designed specifically to set you up for success in your academic studies. You will study the principles of effective writing and learn how to plan, organize, write, edit, and revise your papers. As a new student, you are required to take Power Up. The class is free and pass/fail, but you must complete it within your first year of studies. When you register for classes, you will see this option as GE1000 Power Up. Your professors will love it if you apply what you learn in Power Up in your classes!



As a new student, you are required to take part in our assessment tool before you can register for your first semester of classes. This tool is online and consists of 50 multiple choice questions and is based on the material common to every course of study here at Mid-America. There is no studying required, and whatever you receive will not impact your GPA. In fact, we prefer that you do not study so we get an accurate assessment of your base of knowledge before you enter your undergraduate or graduate program. This assessment allows us as a school to determine how effective our classes are in training and equipping students. At the conclusion of your studies, you will take a post-test to see how your base of knowledge has expanded.

 - The letters in your Student ID must be lowercase
- Click on "My Courses"
- Click on the course "CAMA Pre-Test (Fall 2022)"
- Click on the College at Mid-America Pre-test
- Click "Attempt Quiz Now"
- Complete the test
- Click Submit
- Scroll to the bottom of the summary page and click "Submit All and Finish"
- On the pop-up window, click "Submit All and Finish"
- Congratulations, you've completed the pre-test!



Your Sonis page is the source of much information that you will need throughout the semester. Here are a few tips to help you get the most out of your Sonis account:

- You may reach your Sonis page at
 <u>https://mabtssonis.jenzabarcloud.com</u>. Once there, you'll choose
 "Student" and put in your ID and PIN. Your bio page will appear.
 - Your Advisor's name is in the upper right-hand corner under "Enrollment information." Clicking on his or her name will take you to his or her email address.
 - This page contains three course sections. The first section lists transfer courses, the next section lists completed courses with grades, and the final section lists your current courses.
- The menu on the left contains four tabs.
 - Under General, choose 1098T when you get ready to file your taxes. The Business Office will send out a notice to let you know when those forms are available.

- Under Financial, you will see the current semester's charges and credits, including scholarships.
 - The Nelnet link below the balance may be used until the last day of registration to set up a payment plan. After that date, go to the Custom tab to pay in full.
 - The Ledger tab will give you the same information but will include ALL semesters attended.
- The Academics tab contains a great deal of information. You may view your attendance records for each class under the Attendance tab and any holds you have under the Holds tab.
- The most useful tab is Schedule. Here you may view your courses with times and room numbers.
 - Clicking on the course NUMBER will take you to the professor's course page, which contains a syllabus link.
 - Clicking on the "clipboard" will take you to the forum.
 - Clicking on the red asterisks will show your GRADES thus far.
- Go to the Registration tab to register for classes.

Mid-America Student Housing

Student Housing is located adjacent to the main campus at 1975 E. Beaman Circle, just west of the Appling Road and Goodlett Farms intersection. MASH contains 144 apartments, a community building, playground, and multi-purpose recreational field. The apartments are available in four options: apartments, dormitories, commuter units, and missionary apartments. Payment for apartments and dormitories is not included in Mid-America student tuition. Please consult the 2022-23 Student Handbook to learn more about MASH.

Apartments

The beautiful apartments at MASH can be rented by one or more undergraduate, master, or doctoral level students at the rates shown below. Furniture and utility costs are not included. All apartments include a washer, dryer, refrigerator, dishwasher, and disposal.

Apartment Rates (Beginning May 1, 2022)

\$612/month - 1 bedroom, bath, kitchen, and living area

\$716/month - 2 bedrooms, 2 baths, kitchen, and living area

\$800/month - 3 bedrooms, 2 baths, kitchen, and living area

Married couples and single students are greatly encouraged to live in MASH. Student housing is both affordable and conveniently located next to Mid-America. Single students may choose to live alone or choose other single roommates that are students of Mid-America.

Residents with Children

Married or single students with children are welcome to live in MASH. All family units must have at least one student enrolled in classes (at least one course) per semester. The apartments are zoned for Shelby County Schools, which consist of Dexter Elementary, Dexter Middle, and Cordova High. There are also many private Christian schools in the area and an active homeschool network.

Dorms

MASH offers affordable male and female dorm rooms for undergraduate students. Some exceptions may apply for master and doctoral level students. MASH does not offer coed dorms. All associate and bachelor level students are encouraged to live in the dorms. The expectations of students living in the dorms are as follows: single, no children, and 18-24 years of age (some exceptions may apply).

Each dorm consists of three individual bedrooms and two bathrooms. These three-bedroom units contain one master bedroom and two single bedrooms. Residents renting the master bedroom will utilize a private bathroom connected directly to the master bedroom. Residents living in a single bedroom will utilize a shared bathroom with easy access in the adjoining hallway. Dorm units will not house more than three students at a time.

Students living in the dorms have their own bedroom, but they will share a kitchen, appliances, and living spaces. Each unit includes a full-size washer, dryer, refrigerator, dishwasher, and disposal. The dorm rates also include furniture and utility costs. Internet and cable are not provided.

\$362/month – single bedroom/shared bathroom \$382/month – master bedroom/private bathroom

Commuter Residents

MASH has two apartment units dedicated for short-term housing for PhD or DMin students, prospective students, guests of Mid-America, and visiting faculty. These units are fully furnished and are available for rent per night. Please contact the office of Student Life for details on rates and availability by emailing studentlife@mabts.edu.

Leases

Degree-seeking students must sign a 10-12-month lease based on the academic year (beginning in August). Students who start classes in the Spring semester will need to sign a 5-7-month lease and then renew a 10-12-month lease on schedule with other academic year students in order to live in MASH. Residents of MASH must keep their rental account current. If a student or resident fails to make their monthly rent payment(s), they will be given notice to pay their rent in full or face consequences up to a 30-day notice to vacate the premises.

Registration Reminder

Students who have an outstanding balance regarding their MASH rent will not be allowed to register for future classes until the rent balance is current and approval is provided from the MASH office to the Mid-America registrar's office. MASH status impacts graduation: residents must settle their housing accounts to be eligible to graduate. In the event a student owes rent, fees, or other charges for student housing, he or she will not receive a diploma or graduate until their outstanding balance is paid in full.


Graduation

Upon graduating from MABTS or CAMA, residents of MASH will be given 60 days to vacate the premises or sign a new lease with MASH (depending on availability). Graduates planning to move out must submit a 30-day written notice to the Housing Office by the first of the month at least one month prior to moving out. Residents must fill out a housing extension form to request to stay in MASH more than 60 days past graduation and return it to the Student Life office to be reviewed for approval.









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
